Rudná Elementary School, Prague-West District, is situated in a large area in the middle of the town bearing the same name. It currently consists of 4 buildings. The oldest of them was inaugurated on September 4, 1967 when it had 12 classrooms (Building A).

Due to Rudná's lucrative location, its population has been constantly increasing since the early 1990s. The original capacity of the school soon became insufficient, and therefore its extension (building B) was put into operation on January 20, 2003.

Building C, built with the co-financing of European funds, opened its doors to new school children in September 2010.

The last construction phase of the school began in 2018, when its existing premises became insufficient for such large numbers of school children again. The following two phases were co-financed by the Czech Government program. First, a sports hall, school canteen and changing rooms were built and opened on September 1, 2019. Subsequently, building D began to serve the children and teachers on September 1, 2020.

Currently, the school has a total of 49 classrooms, 13 of which are specialized. The school is now attended by 900 pupils which is its maximum.
